## Ethical Statement

Our objective of delivering pioneering projects, research, policy and solutions in order to establish social equality and environmental justice is undertaken through an adherence to our ethical policy. This policy highlights our commitment to four key ethical areas of: human rights, inclusion, corporate responsibility (fair trade) and ecological impacts.

### Human Rights

In practice we promote inclusion through our extensive work in providing access to environmental information and opportunities for decision-making for economically and socially excluded communities and groups.
